

The "Our Constitution Is Outdated" Myth

I, John Everette Russell O2 335 295, having been appointed an officer in the Army of the United States, as indicated above in the grade of 1LT do solemnly swear (or affirm) that ***I will support and defend the Constitution of the United States against all enemies, foreign and domestic***

that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the same; that I take this obligation freely, without any mental reservation or purpose of evasion; and that I will well and faithfully discharge the duties of the office upon which I am about to enter;

so help me God

[Italics and bold mine].

In my opinion, some judges and some politicians have violated our constitution and have become "domestic enemies" of the United States. It grieves me.

What are we to do? Shall we be true to our word? Or shall we ignore the erosion of freedom and hope it will reverse on its own accord? This would be naive.

The Fabian Socialists who have subverted our Constitution will not reverse themselves. They will have to be converted back to our Constitution or else be removed from power.
